The purpose of this organization is to encourage the study, collecting, & display of minerals, fossils, and gems. We study the geologic formations of our area as well as other locations. We also offer the art of hand-crafted lapidary and jewelry making.

We have numerous classes throughout the year to assist in the development of whatever interests you may have, including making chains & cabs, intarsia, mineral ID, silversmithing, filigree and others. The second Thursday of the month is "Cookie Night" where we have volunteers sign up to bring cookies. We begin at 6:30 pm with socialization time. At 7:00 we have a program followed by a business meeting.

We also have a meeting on the fourth Thursday of the month, with socialization at 6:30pm and a program at 7pm. We will have guest speakers for one or both of the monthly meetings. There is only one meeting in December – it is on the second Thursday only and it is our annual Christmas dinner.

We expect all members to participate in volunteer opportunities that are necessary for the club to function. Volunteers are needed for our meeting nights, which include greeters, and clubhouse cleaners. Please do what you can to help, remembering this is your club, so take your turn to assist. We also need volunteers to serve in the various positions on the Board of Directors.

Annually, we have a Gem & Mineral Show. All members are encouraged to participate and are invited to attend designated show meetings. The show chairman appoints committees to organize the show. There are many opportunities to volunteer: pre-show organizing, participating in one of our many stations at the show, setup and takedown processes.

Our field trip committee has interesting and fun trips scheduled throughout the year. Field trip map books for purchase are stored in our library and are available through our librarian to all members.

Open shop is held on Wednesdays from 12:00 pm to 3:00 pm and Saturdays from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm to utilize our equipment and share ideas with your peers. There will be someone there to help you use the equipment properly. Please obey the shop steward and rules of the shop. A minimal fee is charged.
